Summary of the Ordinary Council Meeting

Council's final meeting for 2024 was held on Friday 13th December with the following matters considered:

- Annual Report. Council accepted the annual report for year ending 30th June, 2024.
- Monthly Financial Statements. These documents contain comprehensive information on the Shire's current financial position.
- Accounts for Payment. This includes all spending by the Shire for the month.
- Driver Access and Equity Grant. Council accepted additional funds from the Department of Transport to continue and expand the existing driving program after a successful funding application.
- Community Grants Round. Recommendations were made to Council by the assessment panel, with applicants due to be notified of outcomes and reporting requirements this week.
